## **Traffic Management Information**

### **For Support Crew**

- All Support Crew must wear NZTA CoPTTM Approved Day / Night Safety Vest at All Times while the tour is in progress.
- Please ensure any vehicle signage remains on the vehicle and is viewed the same as the supplied diagram at all times during the tour.
- You will be supplied with a radio, at times there will not be coverage between all radio users, please relay messages between radio users so that the correct Support Crew receive the information intended for them.
- Please ensure that if you have to stop on the side of the road that you park in a safe position and if you have cyclists with you please ensure that they move well off the side of the road so as not to cause a hazard for other road users.
- If in the case of any emergency **Please contact :**

- In case of any injury
  - Ensure the injured person is in no danger of further injury
  - Assess what injuries are / apply first aid / do not move patient if neck or back injuries are suspected / check airways, breathing, circulation
  - Contact Peter O'Brien and / or Ted Pearce immediately and the tour Doctor will be dispatched via radio or cell phone
  - For serious harm injuries Do Not Interfere with the accident scene (unless necessary to prevent further harm).
  - If necessary place cones around the scene to make it safer and most importantly keep yourself safe.
